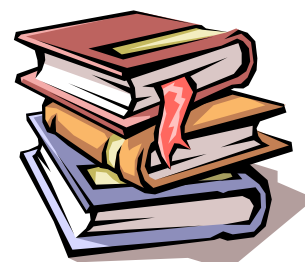
K/1 Supply List 2009 - 2010

Welcome to another exciting year at Sand Pine Elementary. Below is a list of minimum supplies for our K/1 classes. Each teacher or team may have one or two other requirements that will be shared at the beginning of the school year.

Also, please understand that buying items on this supply list is completely voluntary. Help is always appreciated, but we recognize that these are difficult economic times and things may be tight for many families. We have tried to prioritize the needs in this year's supply list. Please do not label supplies with your child's name.

Each student needs to bring:

- 3 pocketed folders with prongs (plastic only, please)
- 12 sharpened pencils with erasers (No mechanical pencils)
- 2 boxes of 24 crayons
- 1 box of washable markers
- 12 glue sticks (Elmer's brand is preferred)
- 2 composition books (Primary is preferred but not required)

- paper plates
- hand soap

Each student should have:

- 8 pocketed folders with prongs (2 of each color; red, blue, yellow and green)
- 2 composition notebooks
- 24 pencils with erasers (No mechanical pencils)
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 1 box of washable markers
- 6 glue sticks

Also, please understand that buying items on this supply list is completely voluntary. Help is always appreciated, but we recognize that these are difficult economic times and things may be tight for many families. We have tried to prioritize the needs in this year's supply list.

Each student should have:

- 1 - 1" white three-ring binders with plastic covering (**No Trapper Keepers, please!**)
- 3 pocketed folders with prongs (red, blue, and yellow)
- 3 packages of wide-ruled notebook paper
- 2 package of regular tabbed dividers
- 2 composition notebooks
- A pencil box filled with the following items for your child's personal use:
 - 24 pencils with erasers (No mechanical pencils)
 - 2 boxes of 16 crayons
 - 1 box of colored pencils
 - 1 box of washable markers
 - 4 glue sticks
 - personal pencil sharpener
 - scissors
